

1 Timothy 2:1-2

"First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way."

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 6

Question 16: Why must He be truly human and truly righteous?

Answer 16: God's justice demands it: man has sinned, man must pay for his sin;

Question 17: Why must He also be true God?

Answer 17: So that, by the power of His divinity, He might bear the weight of God's anger in His humanity.

Question 18: And who is this Mediator-- true God and at the same time truly human and truly righteous?

Answer 18: Our Lord Jesus Christ,

Question 19: How do you come to know this?

Answer 19: The holy gospel tells me. God Himself began to reveal the gospel already in Paradise; finally, He fulfilled it through His own dear Son.

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 7

Question 20: Are all men saved through Christ just as all were lost through Adam?

Answer 20: No. Only those are saved who by true faith accept all His blessings.

Question 21: What is true faith?

Answer 21: True faith is not only a knowledge and conviction that everything God reveals in His Word is true; it is also a deep-rooted assurance, created in me by the Holy Spirit through the gospel, that I have been made forever right with God.

Question 22: What then must a Christian believe?

Answer 22: Everything in the gospel summarized in the articles of our Christian faith.

Question 23: What are these articles?

Answer 23: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate; was crucified, dead, and buried; He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and sitteth at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living & the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit; I believe a holy catholic church, the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.
