### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 10

**Question 27:** What do you understand by the providence of God?

**Answer 27:** Providence is the power of God by which He upholds, as with His hand, heaven and earth and all creatures, and so rules them that all things come to us not by chance but from His fatherly hand.

**Question 28:** How does the knowledge of God's creation and providence help us?

**Answer 28:** We can be patient, thankful, and for the future we can have good confidence that nothing will separate us from His love.

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 11

**Question 29:** Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning "Savior"?

**Answer 29:** Because He saves us from our sins.
