In other words, God alone saves people by sovereignly and graciously giving them faith in Jesus Christ and a trust in his sacrifice for them on the cross as a full payment for their sins (Ephesians 2:8-9).

The Bible is the infallible source of doctrine and direction for our lives as we strive by the Holy Spirit to continually bring our teachings and lifestyle into ever-closer conformity with God's will.



Nahum 1:3

*"The Lord is slow to anger and great in power,  
and the Lord will by no means clear the guilty.

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 12

**Question 31:** Why is He called "Christ," meaning "anointed"?

**Answer 31:** Because He has been ordained by God the Father and has been anointed with the Holy Spirit to be our chief Prophet and Teacher our only High Priest and our eternal King.

**Question 32:** But why are you called a Christian?

**Answer 32:** Because by faith I am a member of Christ and so I share in His anointing. I am anointed to confess His name, to present myself to Him as a living sacrifice, to strive against sin and the devil.

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 13

**Question 33:** Why is He called God's "only begotten Son" when we also are God's children?

**Answer 33:** Because Christ alone is the eternal, natural Son of God. We, however, are adopted children of God.

**Question 34:** Why do you call Him "our Lord"?

**Answer 34:** Because with His precious blood. He has bought us, body and soul, to be His very own.
