

Nahum 1:3

and the Lord will by no means clear the guilty.  
His way is in whirlwind and storm, and the  
clouds are the dust of his feet."*

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 14

**Question 35:** What does it mean that He "was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary"?

**Answer 35:** That the eternal Son of God, took to Himself, through the working of the Holy Spirit, from the flesh and blood of the virgin Mary, a truly human nature.

**Question 36:** How does the holy conception and birth of Christ benefit you?

**Answer 36:** He is our Mediator.  
He removes from God's sight my sin.

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 15

**Question 37:** What do you understand by the word "suffered"?

**Answer 37:** That during His whole life on earth, but especially at the end, Christ sustained the anger of God. That He might set us free from eternal condemnation.

**Question 38:** Why did He suffer "under Pontius Pilate" as judge?

**Answer 38:** So that He, though innocent, might free us from the judgment of God.

**Question 39:** Is it significant that he was "crucified" instead of dying some other way?

**Answer 39:** Yes. Since death by crucifixion was accursed by God.
