

Habakkuk 3:19

*"GOD, the Lord, is my strength; he makes my feet like the deer's; he makes me tread on my high places. To the choirmaster: with stringed instruments."*

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 17

**Question 45:** How does Christ's resurrection benefit us?

**Answer 45:** He has overcome death,  
We are already now resurrected to a new life.

### Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 18

**Question 46:** What do you mean by saying, "He ascended into Heaven"?

**Answer 46:** That Christ, while His disciples watched, was lifted up from the earth into heaven and will be there for our good until He comes again.

**Question 47:** But isn't Christ with us until the end of the world as He promised us?

**Answer 47:** In His human nature Christ is not now on earth; but in His divinity He is not absent from us for a moment.

**Question 48:** If His humanity is not present wherever His divinity is, then aren't the two natures of Christ separated from each other?

**Answer 48:** Certainly not. Christ's divinity is surely beyond the bounds of the humanity He has taken on, but remains personally united to His humanity.

**Question 49:** How does Christ's ascension into heaven benefit us?

**Answer 49:** First, He pleads our cause in heaven.  
Second, we have our own flesh in heaven.  
Third, He sends His Spirit to us on earth.
