We unashamedly believe God's Word to be inerrant, infallible, and unchanging (2 Timothy 3:16). The Reformation also recovered the glorious biblical truth of salvation by grace alone. In other words, God alone saves people by sovereignly and graciously giving them faith in Jesus Christ and a trust in his sacrifice for them on the cross as a full payment for their sins (Ephesians 2:8-9).

We are a **Bible** church because we believe the Bible to be the true and complete word of salvation. The Bible is the infallible source of doctrine and direction for our lives as we strive by the Holy Spirit to continually bring our teachings and lifestyle into ever-closer conformity with God's will.

Our name **Church** means that we have a unique identity with Jesus. We are not a social club. Christ gathers us together by His Spirit and Word to worship and serve Him (John 10:14-16). We confess that Jesus Christ is the sovereign King of the Church (Colossians 1:18). 

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 19

Question 50: Why the next words: "and sitteth at the right hand of God"?

Answer 50: To show that He is Head of His church, that the Father rules all things through Him.

Question 51: How does this glory of Christ our head benefit us?

Answer 51: First, through his Holy Spirit. He pours out His gifts from heaven. Second, by His power He defends us and keeps us safe.

Question 52: How does Christ's return to judge the living and the dead" comfort you?

Answer 52: All His enemies and mine. He will condemn to everlasting punishment: but me and all His chosen ones. He will take along with Him into the joy and the glory of heaven.
