

WSRBC CHURCH CHALLENGE August 2017

Zephaniah 3:13

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 20

Question 53: What do you believe concerning "the Holy Spirit"?

Answer 53: First, He, as well as the Father and the Son, is eternal God. Second, He has been given to me so that He makes me share in Christ.

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 21

Question 54: What do you believe concerning "the holy catholic church"?

Answer 54: I believe that the Son of God through His Spirit and Word, gathers, protects, and preserves for Himself a community chosen for eternal life.

Question 55: What do you understand by "the communion of saints"?

Answer 55: First, that believers share in Christ and in all His treasures and gifts. Second, that each member should use these gifts for the service of the other members.
