

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 22

Question 57: How does "the resurrection of the body" comfort you?

Answer 57: My soul will be taken immediately after this life to Christ, even my very flesh, will be made like Christ's glorious body.

Question 58: How does the article concerning "life everlasting" comfort you?

Answer 58: Even as I already now experience in my heart the beginning of eternal joy, so after this life I will have perfect blessedness in which to praise God eternally.

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 23

Question 59: What good does it do you, however, to believe all this?

Answer 59: In Christ I am right with God and heir to life everlasting.

Question 60: How are you right with God?

Answer 60: Only by true faith in Jesus Christ. Even though my conscience accuses me and even though I am still inclined toward all evil, nevertheless, God grants and credits to me the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ,

Question 61: Why do you say that by faith alone you are right with God?

Answer 61: It is not because of any value my faith has that God is pleased with me. Only Christ's satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness make me right with God.
